



RIB rafting trip full of history

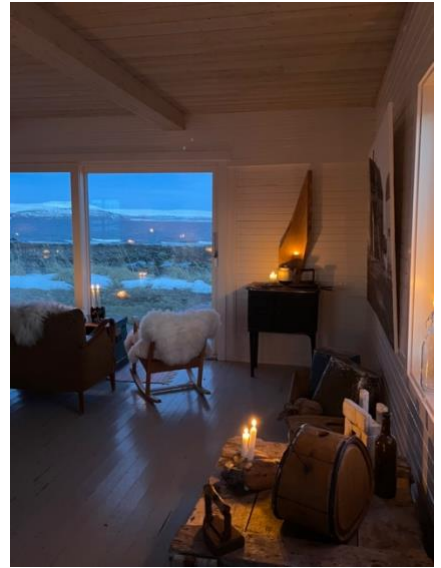
A 3 hour RIB rafting trip with a twist. Experience the history of Tamsøya, get the adrenaline pumping, taste some home made local sweets and go for a relaxing beach walk among the birds.

The trip with us to Tamsøya begins at 12:00 (12pm) on the old ferry pier in Repvåg. You can park your car for free along the fence of the large blue house with a red barn. From there, you'll be a passenger on our 600 horse powered, 35 feet RIB boat, and the ride to and from the island will last for about 20 minutes each. The boat has a passenger capacity of 12, and everyone will be equipped with regatta (floatation) suits and life vests.

On the way to the island we'll raft past Sjøholmen and get a closer look at the birds that live on its cliffs. From there, we'll set course towards Tamsøya. Here you'll be guided around the old houses and learn about the history of this special place and we'll serve local, homemade treats for you to try. You'll learn about how life was here in the old days, war history, how they gathered down, the cloudberry and about our family cloudberry business.
